Library staff determined that these two donations should be processed as one comprehensive collection.

#### **Historical Note**

The professional organization now known as The Association for the Study of Play (TASP) was originally founded as The Association for the Anthropological Study of Play (TAASP) in Minneapolis, Minnesota, in 1973 by Alyce T. Cheska and a group of scholars interested in play studies and research.

TASP is a multidisciplinary organization whose purposes are to promote the study of play, support and cooperate with other organizations having similar purposes, and organize meetings and publications that facilitate the sharing and dissemination of information related to the study of play. Its broad focus includes many disciplines and scholarly interests. TASP holds an annual conference for its members and publishes the ongoing *Play & Culture Studies* book series.

## **Collection Scope and Content Note**

The Association for the Study of Play (TASP) records are a collection of documentation from the Association for the Anthropological Study of Play (TAASP, 1973-1986) and the Association for the Study of Play (TASP, 1987-present). Materials in this collection include correspondence, memos, notes, minutes, membership forms, brochures, programs, financial records, publications, and reference. Within the Conferences series are also audiocassettes of recordings from various TASP conferences. Additional scope and content information can be found under the Contents List section of this finding aid.

The Association for the Study of Play (TASP) records have been arranged into six series, one of which has been further divided into subseries. The materials are housed in 12 archival document boxes and one oversized folder.

#### **Related Materials**

The Brian Sutton-Smith Library and Archives of Play at The Strong houses the personal library and papers of Brian Sutton-Smith, a former TASP President and committed TASP member. Among the books and serials belonging to Sutton-Smith were multiple copies of TASP publications, such as the *Play & Culture* journal and the *Play & Culture Studies* book series; many of these were annotated by Sutton-Smith.

Also in the archives are the professional papers of Linda A. Hughes, another play scholar and past TASP President.

## Subseries A: Member newsletters, 1977-2009

**Scope and Content Note:** This subseries holds member newsletters for TAASP/TASP, starting with Volume 3 in 1977 and running through Volume 32 in 2009.

From 1995 onward, the TASP newsletter was issued three times each year rather than four. Occasionally the issues for two quarters were combined into one. For most years the volume year ran from Spring (Issue 1) through Winter (Issue 3 or 4), with Winter being issued in January or February of the following calendar year. (For example, Spring 1995 and Winter 1996 would be part of the same volume number). There are, however, a few variations in this scheme from time to time, including 1990 when only a Spring and Winter issue were produced, or 1989 which has only a Summer and Winter issue.
